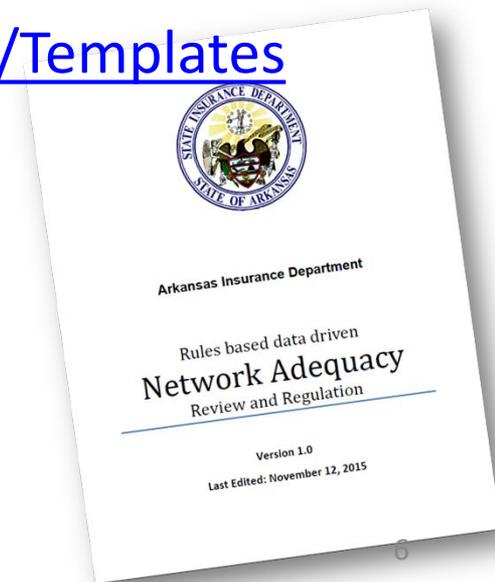
- These meetings on Network Adequacy apply to all health and dental insurance carriers *covered under Rule 106.*

- **These Provider Type NPI lists is an input for the average distance calculation programs that generate the reports required for submission to AID.**
- **AID has observed justifications that come later in the process stating that provider(s) has been mis-classified with the argument that the access statistics is actually better than it appears.**

This is your chance to avoid the need for such justifications.

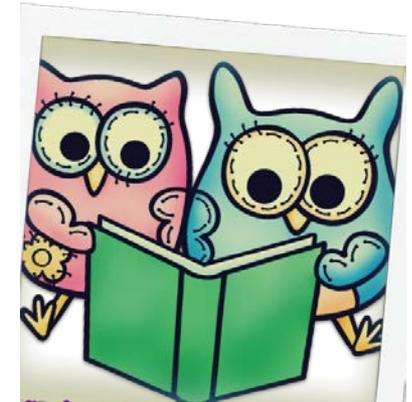

Observations

- Provider-Type-NPI-Pools appear to be undergoing aggressive reductions except for the Dental Provider Types
- The PY2017 finalized list included NPI's from issuers who may not be active participants in the ongoing Provider-Type-NPI-Pool data maintenance. It is possible that they may find their contracted NPI's disappearing from the agreed upon list.
- Large majority of removals are in agreement with at least two issuers
- Large majority of removals appear to be of non-Arkansan provider locations

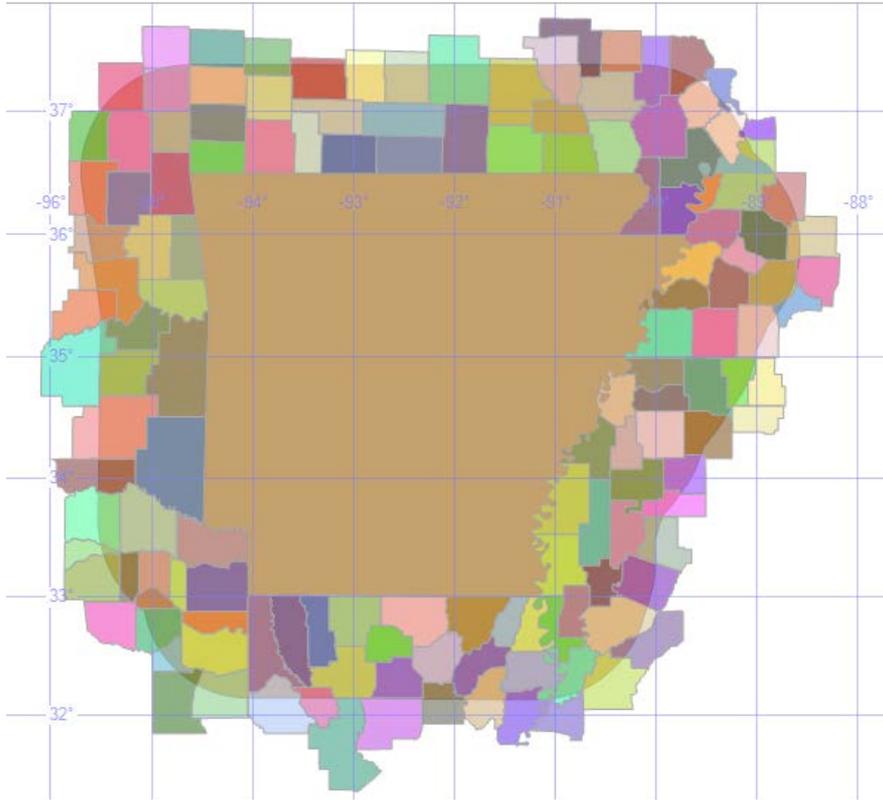

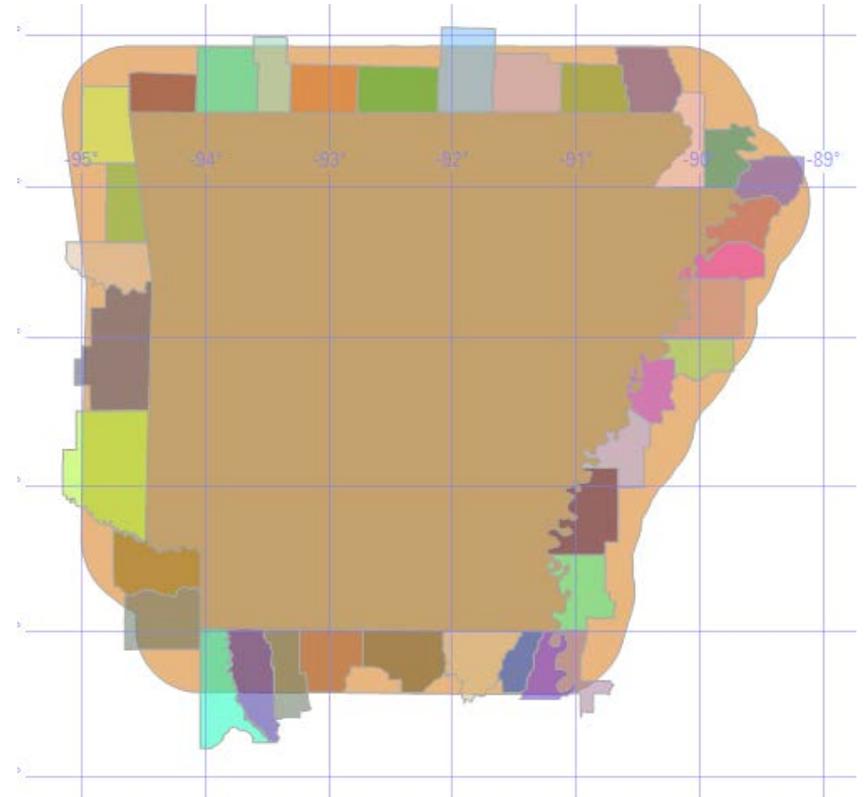
